

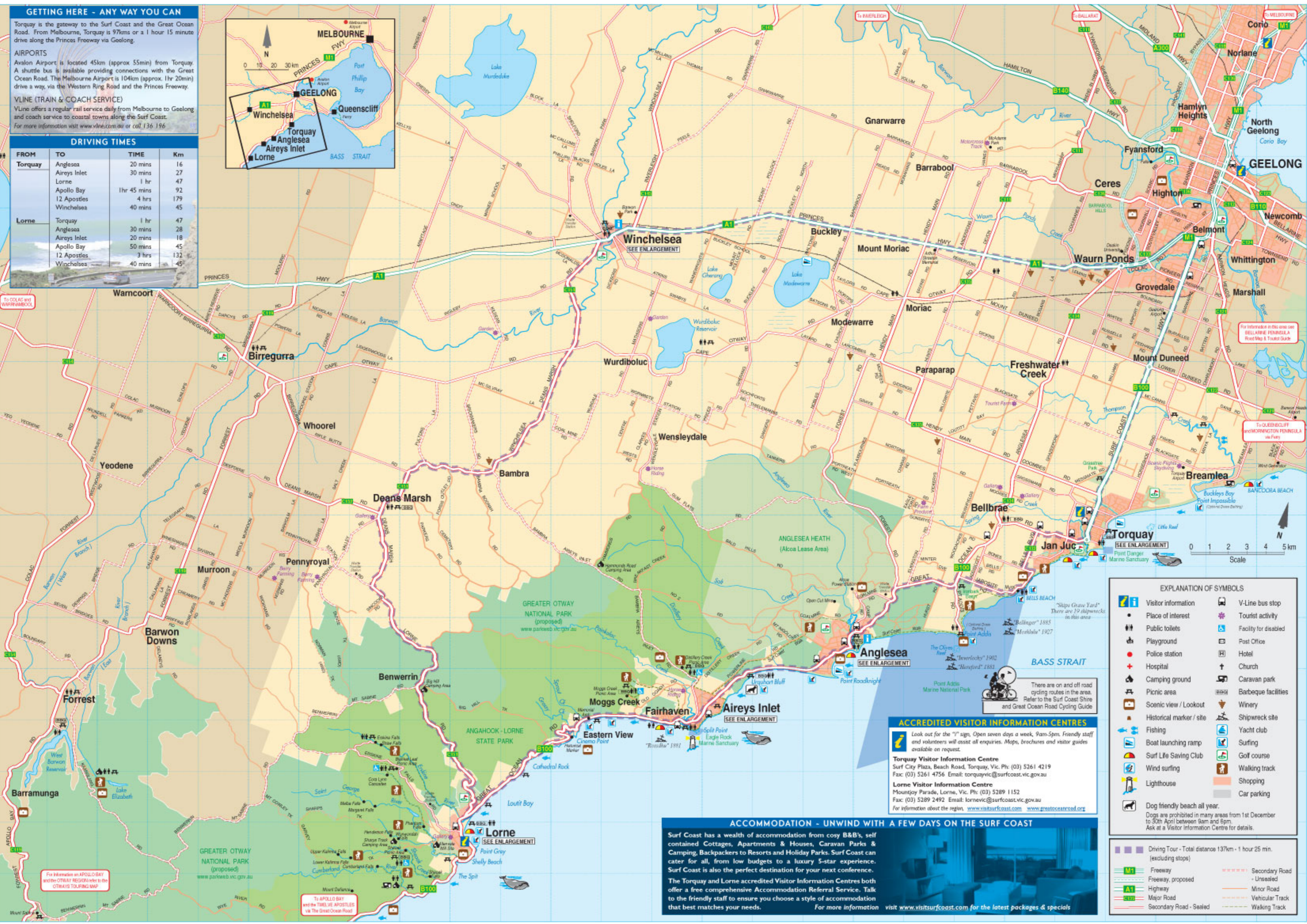
GETTING HERE - ANY WAY YOU CAN

Torquay is the gateway to the Surf Coast and the Great Ocean Road. From Melbourne, Torquay is 97km or a 1 hour 15 minute drive along the Princes Freeway via Geelong.

AIRPORTS
Avalon Airport is located 45km (approx 55min) from Torquay. A shuttle bus is available providing connections with the Great Ocean Road. The Melbourne Airport is 104km (approx. 1hr 20min) drive a way, via the Western Ring Road and the Princes Freeway.
